

## Case study #4 – Private school, Chicago

Located in an urban transitional zone, this school faced stray gunfire from neighboring buildings.

As a high-end private school for special needs children, administrators looked into conventional bullet proof glass. Cost estimates ranged in excess of \$2M and required months of scheduled construction time.

ACE undertook the project for \$320,000 with the work scheduled just after the Christmas break in 2016 to minimize impact on students. Work was completed in 12 days.



Total cost with ACE: \$320,000  
Savings compared to ballistic glass: + \$2M
